Art Shirts

Ask children to donate an old shirt to their class art shirt box for light Art/DT activities. Please discard any really old, grotty ones you already have.

For health reasons, wash your class art shirts at least once a term to minimize germs. (Don't mix them with ordinary washing! Do this at your own risk to the washing machine.)

The best bought art shirts are the nylon ones with arms that fasten at the back.

Messy 'art kit': ask the children to bring a set of old clothes in a named bag that they can hang on their peg during term. These can be used for really messy, dirty projects and especially when using acrylic paints which do not come out of clothes, even if wearing an art shirt over uniforms. The paint can easily soak through these.
