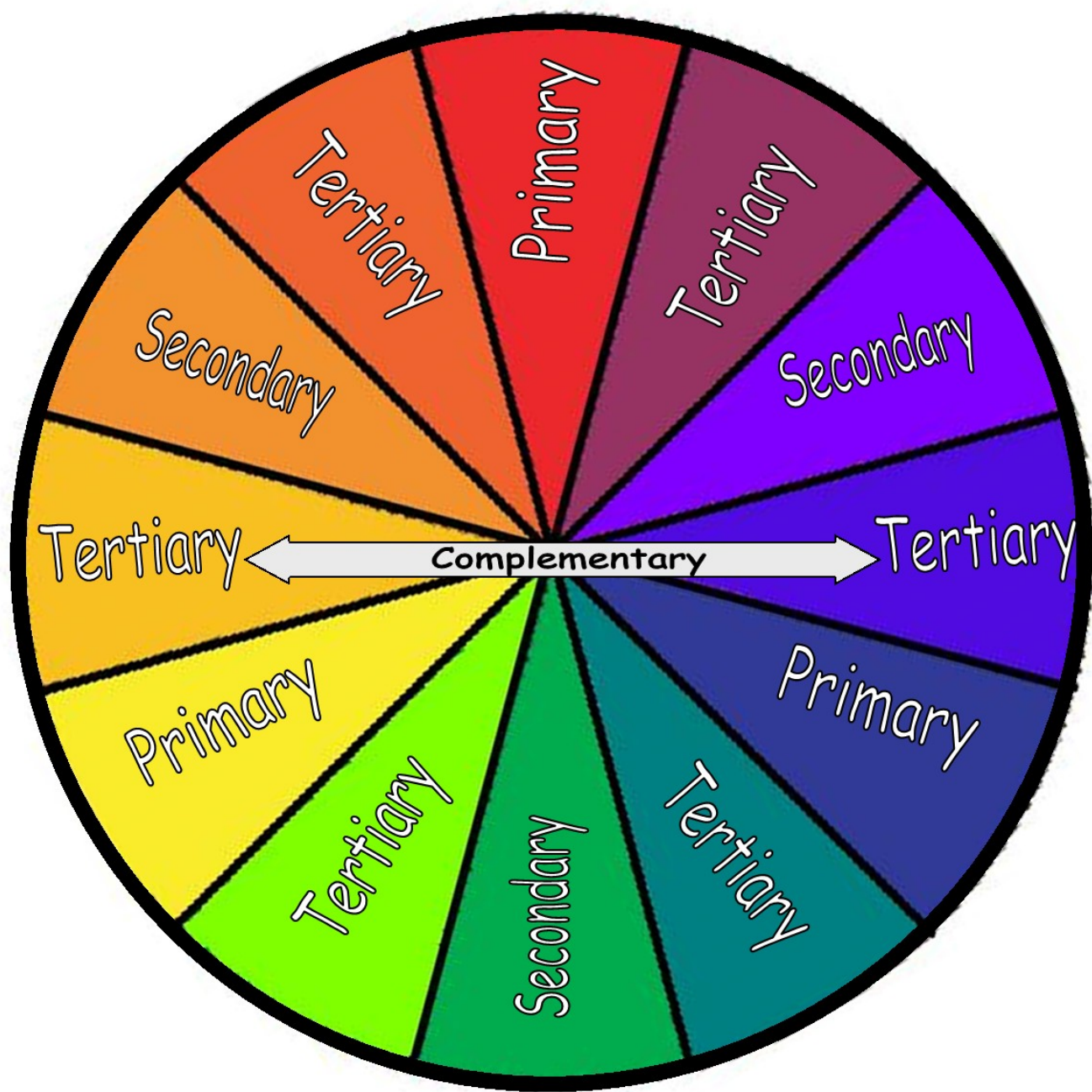
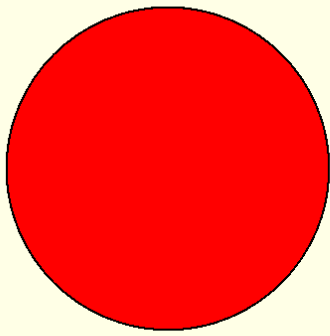


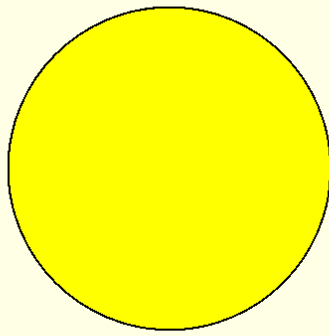
The Colour Wheel



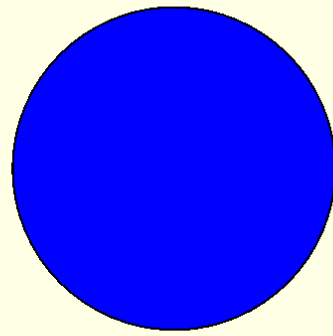
3 primary colours

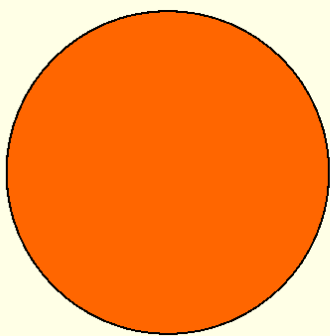

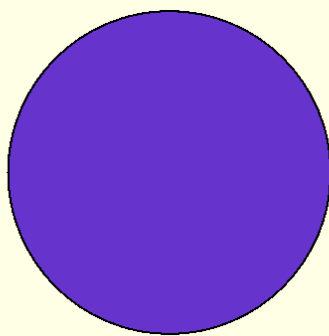

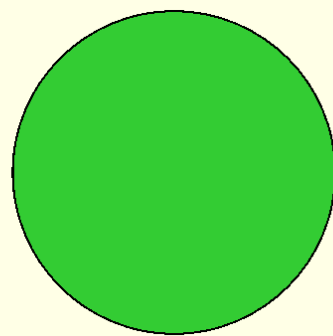
3 secondary colours



orange

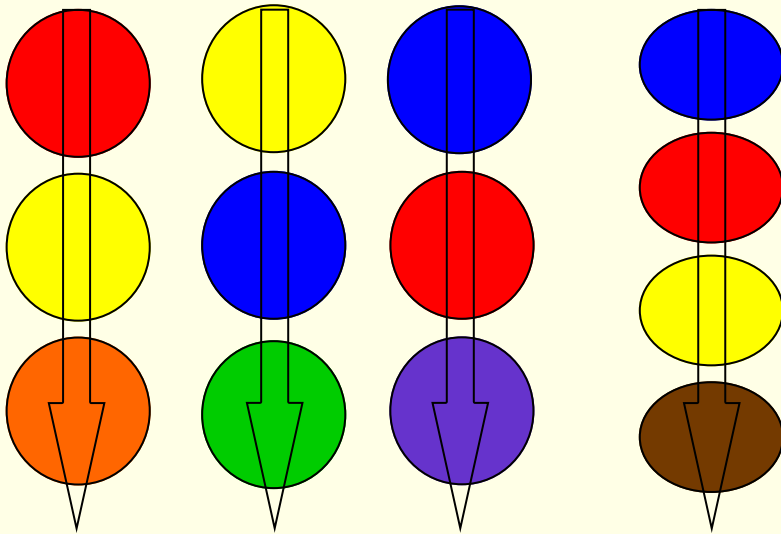

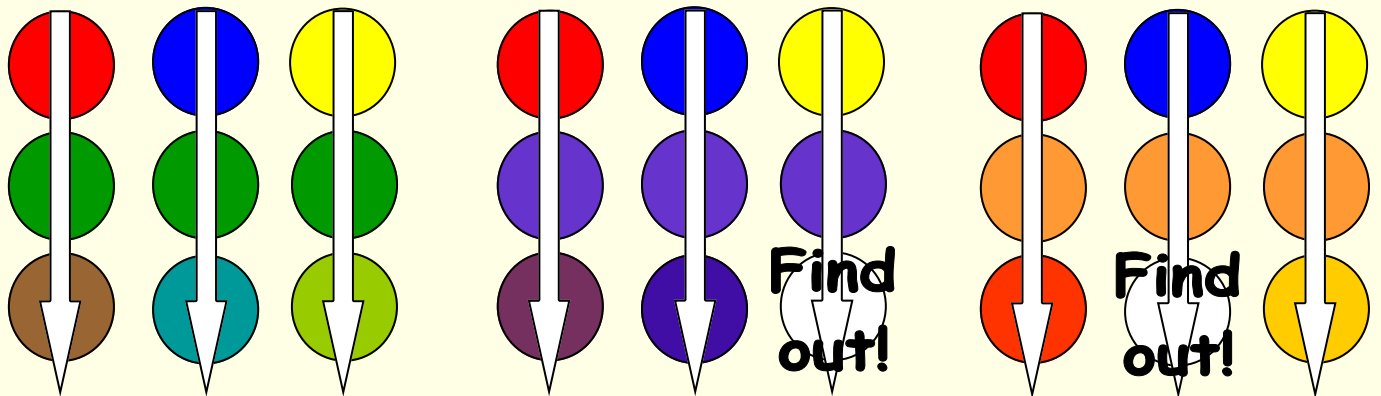
Mix the primary colours to make the secondary colours and brown.



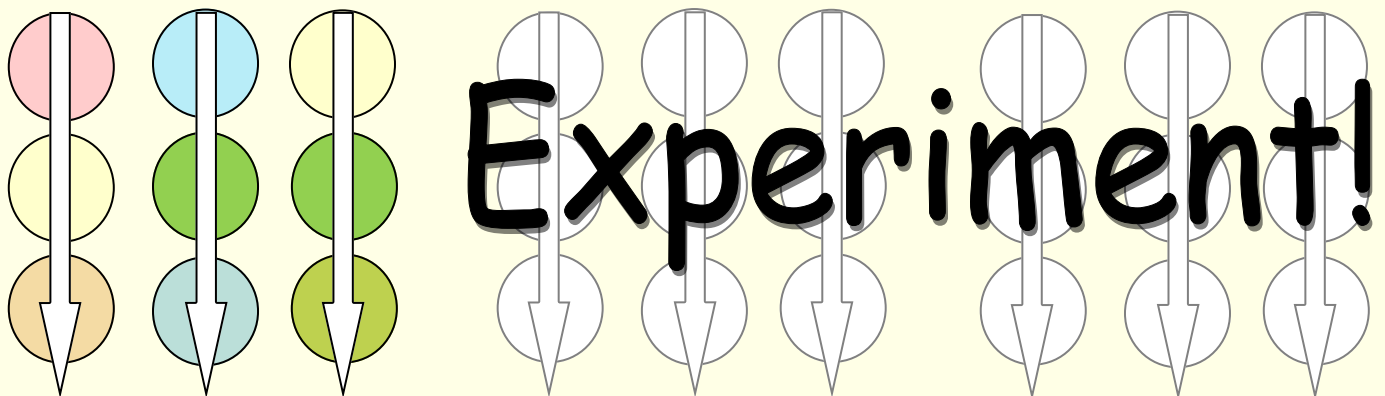
Secondary Colours

Mix a primary colour with a secondary colour to make a tertiary colour.



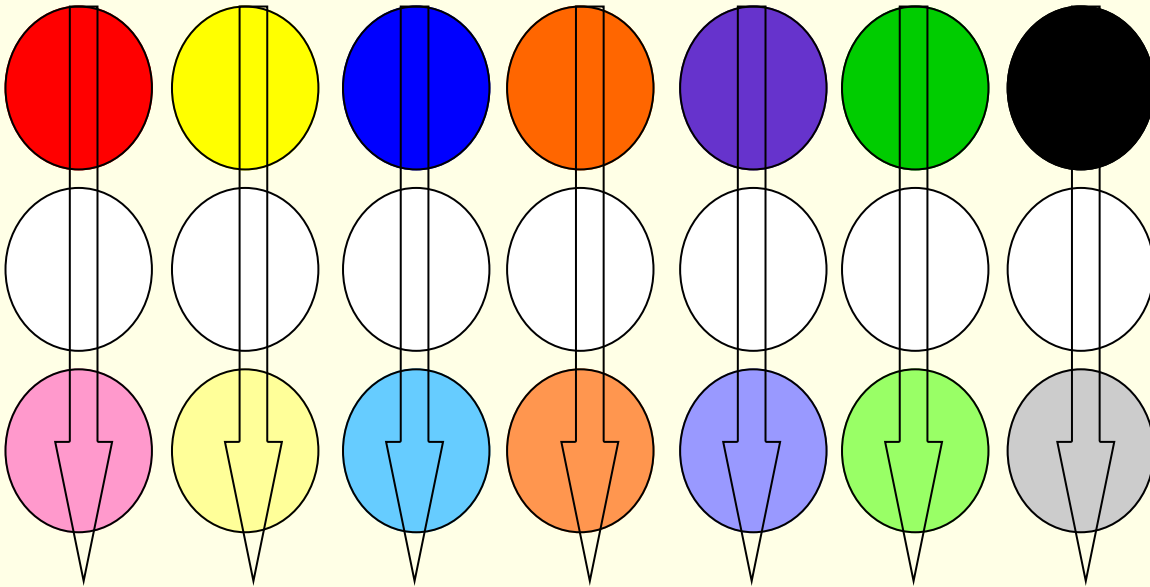
Mix a shade of a primary colour with a shade of a secondary colour to make loads of tertiary colours. Experiment! What would you call all the colours you create?



Tints & Shades of Colour

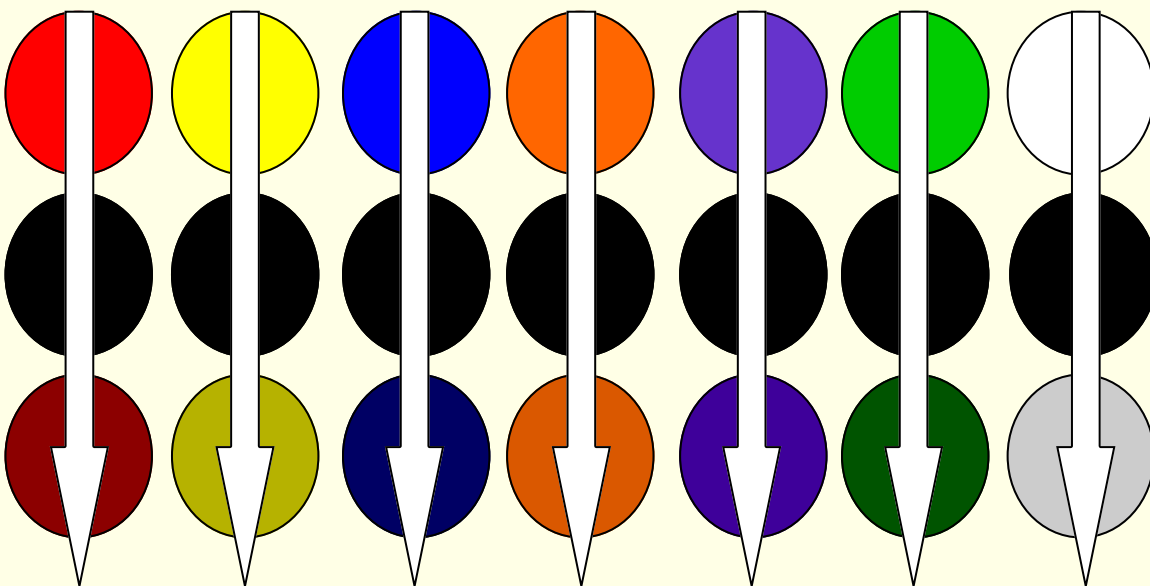
Mixing in white makes colours lighter (a tint).
