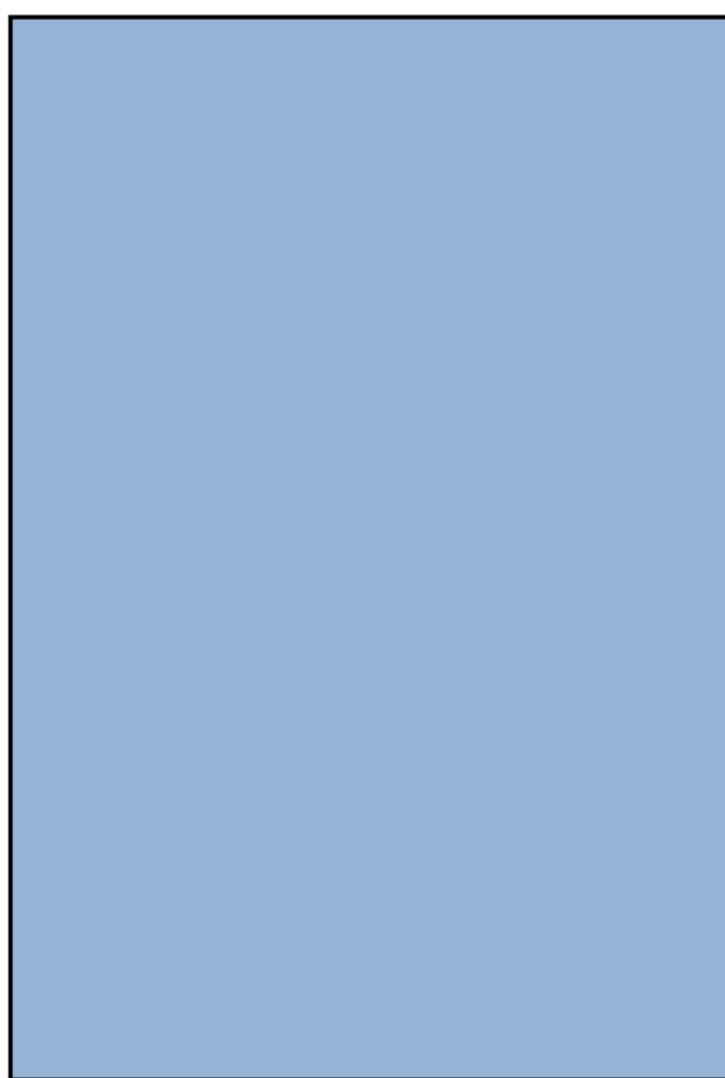


Viewfinder - rectangular



You don't have to draw everything! Choose a view you like by looking through the view finder and draw that. Perhaps you could secure the viewfinder to the picture with a little Blue Tac. Be very careful not to damage the picture though. (Grown-ups decide on this.)

If the picture is very detailed, you might use the smallest viewfinder. Little detail: the largest one. Just have a look through and see what you think. What view do you feel most confident with?

Grown-ups: Laminate some of these sheets and then cut out the rectangles. If you're confident and have the tools, use a steel ruler, retractable craft knife and cutting mat. Be careful not to position your body directly behind the knife when you cut, so if you slip you won't cut yourself. Make sure no one is behind you when you cut. Do this type of cutting at your own risk!

Turn the picture round too: you can draw things at an angle! Try not to be predictable. Be creative with your art - surprise people!
