Welcome to the Art Tree Family! These digital resources are available for purchase directly from Julie Mitchell by individual schools that have purchased The Art Tree Subject Leaders' Essential Guide (with or without the companion Key Stage 1/Key Stage 2 books). They relate to/reference, and are for use in conjunction with, the content of the Art Tree book(s), particularly the Subject Leaders' Essential Guide. 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ACCESS

Once purchased from www.artdays.co.uk, the digital resources will be sent to the **headteacher's school email** via WeTransfer (online file-sharing website) after you have received the Art Tree Book(s) that you have already purchased. WeTransfer gives you 7 days to download them. From an official school email address, just email Julie Mitchell with the headteacher's email address and the release code on the delivery note at: julie@artdays.co.uk. You are strongly advised to keep an unaltered master copy of the digital resources separately on your school data system as a backup just in case you lose them, or they become permanently altered or damaged in any way. An administration charge of £30 will be applied if replacements have to be sent.

Please let your staff know: IN PURCHASING THE ART TREE DIGITAL RESOURCES YOU ARE AGREEING TO:

1. Use them solely for your teaching staff (including teaching assistants, learning mentors, SENCos, SENDCos. etc.), pupils and governors. External peripatetic/supply teaching staff may use them in your school but must not give any copies via any means to those outside of your school.
2. Not give them to those yet to purchase – via any means.
3. Not use them to provide CPD (continual professional development)/ITT (initial teacher training)/other training for anyone other than the individual schools' own governors, teaching staff and/or student teachers/teaching assistants.

However, all other digital resources must not be shared on the school website or other public platforms (e.g. social media). This is particularly true of the 2023 year group media growth mastery tables which appear in the books and digital resources.
